A message from our founders

Magic Tooth Bus is a nonprofit mobile dentistry service dedicated to improving oral health among populations in San Francisco and the Bay Area. We deliver essential on-site dental screenings, provide education on dental hygiene to children, adults, and seniors, and assist families with insurance enrollment to ensure access to necessary care.

A year of expanding our reach

This past year, we expanded our reach, welcoming more classrooms to our school-based sealant program and extending services to San Mateo, South San Francisco, and Oakland. With your support, we served over 1,700 individuals and distributed nearly 4,000 dental kits for year 2024—our biggest impact yet! Goals for 2024-2025

Our goals for the coming year include strengthening collaborations with ally nonprofits and partner organizations to better serve neighborhoods and communities with limited access to oral health care. We will remain committed to participating in the SFUSD school-based sealant program, providing oral health education to priority schools, dental outreach to community events, health fairs and launch screening initiatives to school sites and community partners in San Francisco and San Mateo.

Additionally, we aim to enhance our role as a trusted resource for families, offering guidance on oral health care and connecting them to dental services. Through continued outreach and education, Magic Tooth Bus will work to bridge gaps in oral health access across the community.

From mother to child, every toothbrush and lesson we share plants the seeds of lasting oral health, transforming lives one smile at a time

In 2017, the three of us—Seraphine Xieu, Andrea Almario, and Mylene Deano—founded Magic Tooth Bus after witnessing the immense challenges low-income families face in accessing dental care. While working together in a community health clinic, we served homeless and low-income populations and saw the devastating effects of untreated dental issues. From persistent pain and fear to a lack of confidence in smiling, speaking, and even eating, we realized how vital oral health is to overall well-being.

Too often, members of our community—especially children still learning how to care for themselves—suffer needlessly. This inspired us to focus on prevention, aiming to teach and instill lifelong oral health habits. We believe that with the right tools, education, and care, much of this suffering can be avoided.

Every trip Magic Tooth Bus takes is an opportunity to improve our community's oral health. We recall one event hosted by SF Pregnancy Village, where we met a pregnant mother concerned about how her oral health could affect her baby. By providing her with a simple toothbrush kit, brushing techniques, and dental care information, we empowered her to care for herself and her child—a lasting impact passed from mother to child. This is the kind of transformation we strive to create.
