Key Achievements in 2025

Expansion of Services

- **New Locations:** The Magic Tooth Bus added **five** new service areas.
- **Total Visits:** Over visits were conducted, marking a **38% increase** from the previous year.
- **New Partnerships:** Collaborations with local schools and health organizations expanded, resulting in **3 new partnerships**.

Enhanced Educational Programs

- **Oral Health Education:** Provided education for **430 students** at our school-based programs
- **Educational Materials Distributed:** Distributed over **1,100 educational pamphlets** and over **5,900 oral hygiene kits**

Community Impact

- **Community-Building:** Fostered a sense of reliable belonging that inspired residents to return and share their recovery journeys with us
- **Improved Oral Health Awareness:** Inspired patients to take action

Challenges

- **Resource Allocation:** Balancing resources between new and existing service areas to maintain quality and ensuring sustainability to support demand
- **Funding:** Reduction in funding has forcibly contracted our service capacity
- **Political Climate:** Increasing the number of no shows and creating barriers that prevented individuals from receiving necessary care

Future Plans

- **Increase Funding Sources:** Explore additional grants and partnerships to ensure financial stability
- **Service Innovations:** Implement new technologies to enhance service quality and efficiency
- **Community Engagement:** Strengthen community involvement through volunteer opportunities and storytelling
- **Enhance Referral system:** 41% of individuals still do not have a dental home

2025 was a pivotal year for the Magic Tooth Bus, marked by significant growth and community impact. The current reduction in funding is a challenge to our capacity, but not our resolve as we look ahead, we are doubling down on our mission to transform dental care into community power, confident that we will evolve beyond these constraints to build a future where oral health is a reclaimed right for every member of our community.
